Minutes of the 149th meeting of NLCPR Committee held on 21.02.2017 under the Chairmanship of Shri Naveen Verma, Secretary, Ministry of Development of North Eastern Region in Committee Room No 243 A, Vigyan Bhawan Annexe, New Delhi.

Secretary, DoNER welcomed the Committee members and thereafter Joint Secretary (NLCPR) apprised the members that the NLCPR Committee in its 121st meeting held on 18.12.2013 recommended 10 projects for retention. Out of these 10 retained projects, 8 projects have been sanctioned so far. The approved cost of these 8 sanctioned projects is **Rs. 3133.77 lakh** and an amount of **Rs. 1566.88 lakh** have been released against these projects. The remaining two projects, as under, could not be considered for sanction as the vetted DPRs of these two projects were awaited from the State Government of Assam:-

2. After considering the availability of budget provision under special economic package and the vetted DPRs of these two projects with other mandatory certificates of the State Level Standing Committee (SLSC) chaired by Chief Secretary,

Government of Assam, the NLCPR-Committee recommended for **sanction**.

3. Apart from the above two projects, the concept papers of 43 projects proposals submitted by the State Government of Assam *vide* letter dated 07.02.2017 under the Special Economic Package of KAATC were also placed before the Committee as under:-

- (a) PWD (Roads) – 15 projects
- (b) PWD (Building) – 3 projects
- (c) Public Health Engineering – 2 projects
- (d) Irrigation Department – 5 projects
- (e) Cultural Affairs Department – 5 projects
- (f) Library Department – 2 projects
- (g) Museum Department – 2 projects
- (h) Agriculture Department – 2 projects
- (i) Tourism Department – 2 projects
- (j) Water Resources Department – 1 project
- (k) Soil Conservation Department – 3 projects
- (l) A.H & Veterinary Department – 1 project

Accordingly, the Committee discussed these 43 project proposals *vis-à-vis* the Memorandum of Settlement (MoS) and after detailed deliberation, the Committee recommended to retain the projects falling under the sectors of **Roads and Public Health Engineering** in terms of para 9.2 and 9.3 of MoS to the extent that these projects are not covered under PMGSY or any other existing schemes of Central Ministries/Departments. The SLSC may ensure the same while vetting the DPRs of the following **retained** projects:-
