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Minutes of 122<sup>nd</sup> Meeting of NLCPR Committee held on 31.01.2014 at 1100 Hrs under Chairmanship of Secretary, M/o DoNER in Committee Room No.243A, Vigyan Bhavan Annexe New Delhi.

Committee deliberated on the Agenda Items and made following recommendations.

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Item No.1: Confirmation of the minutes of 121<sup>st</sup> Meeting of the NLCPR Committee held on 18.12.2013

Minutes of 121<sup>st</sup> Meeting of NLCPR Committee circulated vide M/o DoNER's OM No. DNER/NLP/6(CXXI)/2013 dated 18.12.2013 were confirmed.

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Item No.2 (a): Action taken report of decision/recommendations made by NLCPR Committee in the 120<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 19.11.2013.

Committee noted that Ministry have taken action on recommendations made in its 120<sup>th</sup> meeting dated 19.11.2013 and no any action is pending, except Ministry's observations on IFD's comments on item No.12 which shall be placed before NLCPR Committee in the next meeting.

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Item No.2 (b): Agenda taken report of decision/recommendations made by NLCPR Committee in the 121<sup>st</sup> Meeting held on 18.12.2013.

Committee noted that Ministry have taken action on recommendations made in its 121<sup>st</sup> meeting dated 18.12.2013 and no any action is pending.

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Item No. 3      Construction of Road from Kapu to Ozakho (13.5 km length, complete upto black-topping level including Culverts, Bridges etc) in Tirap District, Arunachal Pradesh

The Committee noted that the project was retained at an estimated cost of Rs. 13 crore from priority list submitted by Government of Arunachal Pradesh for 2012-13, on recommendation of NLCPR Committee in its 111<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 19.12.2012. It was also noted that the DPR was scrutinized and cost estimates vetted by Ministry of Road Transport & Highways.

After deliberation the Committee recommended the project for sanction at an estimated cost of Rs. 1456.91 lakh as under:

The project has been recommended for sanction with the following conditions:

- a) Award of contract will be on turnkey basis.
- b) Transparency should be maintained in tendering process and the State Government should ensure that the tender has been called on competitive basis by giving wide publicity in print media and website etc. and the works have been awarded within 3 months of its sanction, even without waiting for the release of funds from state government to implementing agency.
- c) The State Government should follow all codal formalities and strictly adhere to the project implementation schedule and physical targets given in the DPR.
- d) The project implementation by the state government will be governed by the rules/conditions stipulated in the guidelines of NLCPR.
- e) Administrative and Financial approval will be issued only on receipt of original copy of no-duplication certificate from State Planning Department.
- f) Implementing agency/State Government will strictly comply with the technical comments made by Ministry of Road Transport & Highways.

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Item No.4: Construction of 33/11 KV, 2x5 MVA Power sub-station at Deopani and providing High Voltage Distribution system in and around Roing Township under Lower Dibang Valley District in Arunachal Pradesh

The Committee noted that the project was retained at an estimated cost of Rs. 15 crore from priority list submitted by Government of Arunachal Pradesh for 2012-13, on recommendation of NLCPR Committee in its 109<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 27.09.2012. It was also noted that the DPR was scrutinized and cost estimates vetted by Central Electricity Authority (CEA), Ministry of Power.

After deliberation the Committee recommended the project for sanction at an estimated cost of Rs. 1403.78 lakh as under:

The project has been recommended for sanction with the following conditions:

- a) Award of contract will be on turnkey basis.
- b) Transparency should be maintained in tendering process and the State Government should ensure that the tender has been called on competitive basis by giving wide publicity in print media and website etc. and the works have been awarded within 3 months of its sanction, even without waiting for the release of funds from state government to implementing agency.
- c) The State Government should follow all codal formalities and strictly adhere to the project implementation schedule and physical targets given in the DPR.
- d) The project implementation by the state government will be governed by the rules/conditions stipulated in the guidelines of NLCPR.
- e) Administrative and Financial approval will be issued only on receipt of no overlapping with the proposed project of Comprehensive Strengthening of Transmission & Distribution from the State.
- f) Implementing agency/State Government will strictly comply with the technical comments made by CEA, Ministry of Power.

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Item No.5: Project "Infrastructure requirement of Police (Establishment of 3<sup>rd</sup> battalion HQ at Thingkah, Lawngtlai district, Mizoram)" under NLCPR scheme;

The committee noted that the above-mentioned project was retained in its 107<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 25.07.2012 at a cost of Rs. 3100.00 lakh from the priority list for year 2012-13 received from State Government.

The committee was informed that IFD, DoNER was not in support of funding the project under NLCPR as "it does not fall within social sector infrastructure and will be against the guidelines". However, in NLCPR guidelines at para 2.2 it is stated that "both

physical and social infrastructure sectors such as Irrigation and Flood Control, Power, Roads & Bridges, Education, Health, Water Supply & Sanitation – are considered for providing support under the Central Pool with projects in physical infrastructure sector receiving priority”. Thus NLCPR guidelines does not debar from funding above project under NLCPR Scheme.

The Committee also noted that State Government was requested by the Ministry of DoNER to explore possible funding for the project from other sources including 13<sup>th</sup> Finance Commissions etc. In reply, Government of Mizoram informed their inability to arrange any alternate source of funding. However, they expressed urgency and necessity to establish the 3<sup>rd</sup> battalion HQ for maintaining peace and tranquility in the State. Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India also supported the funding of the project under NLCPR scheme.

After detailed deliberation, the NLCPR committee noted the necessity and funding constraints presented by the State Government and justification and support extended by the Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India and recommended the project for funding as under:

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Item No.8: Construction of Football Stadium at Tobu Hq in Mon District in Nagaland.

The Committee noted that the project was retained at Rs. 3.00 crore from Priority List 2012-13 of Nagaland in its 107<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 25.07.2012. The DPR of the project was examined by Ministry of Urban Development and vetted it at Rs.271.89 lac. The Committee deliberated in the matter and recommended the project for sanction at Rs.266.56 lac with following components and conditions:

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Item No.11: Replacement of retained project "Establishment of Multipurpose Indoor Hall (Indoor Stadium) at Reshithang, East Sikkim" with project "Construction of Multi-purpose Sports Complex with Office and Car Park near Paljor Stadium at Gangtok, East Sikkim

The Committee noted that Government of Sikkim requested that Construction of Multi-purpose Sports Complex with Office and Car Park near Paljor Stadium at Gangtok (estimated cost Rs.11.32 crore) may be taken up in lieu of a retained project, Establishment of Multipurpose Indoor Hall (Indoor Stadium) at Reshithang, East Sikkim (retention cost Rs.12 crore). It was also noted that the project, Establishment of Multipurpose Indoor Hall (Indoor Stadium) at Reshithang, East Sikkim was retained by NLCPR Committee in its 30<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 17<sup>th</sup> August 2004 at an estimated cost of Rs. 12.00 crore from the Priority List of 2004-05 but could not be sanctioned till date.

After deliberation the Committee recommended for retention of Construction of Multi-purpose Sports Complex with Office and Car Park near Paljor Stadium at Gangtok at estimated cost of Rs.11.32 crore in lieu of Establishment of Multipurpose Indoor Hall (Indoor Stadium) at Reshithang, East Sikkim.

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Item No.12: Remodeling of Power Distribution System at Rangpo Town, East Sikkim

The Committee noted that the project was retained at an estimated cost of Rs. 15 crore from priority list submitted by Government of Sikkim for 2011-12, on recommendation of NLCPR Committee in its 100<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 28.11.2011. It was also noted that the DPR was scrutinized and cost estimates vetted by Central Electricity Authority (CEA), Ministry of Power.

After deliberation the Committee recommended the project for sanction at an estimated cost of Rs. 1470.59 lakh as under:

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Item No. 13: Construction of Bus Terminal at Nagerjala, Agartala in Tripura

The Committee noted that the project was retained at an estimated cost of Rs. 14.98 crore from priority list submitted by Government of Tripura for 2012-13, on recommendation of NLCPR Committee in its 106<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 18.06.2012. It was also noted that the DPR was prepared by NBCC which as per O.M. No. 0-17034/21/2012-PS dated 13.05.2013 of Ministry of Urban Development the practice of sending NBCC estimates to CPWD for vetting was not called for, subject to NBCC certifying that the estimates were strictly in accordance with latest CPWD norms/schedule of rates. NBCC have submitted that requisite certificate.

After deliberation the Committee recommended the project for sanction at an estimated cost of Rs. 1688.90 lakh as under:

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Item No.14: Project – “Widening and Improvement of Barbora-Minirgon–Chapakhowa Road including conversion of SPT bridge No.7/1 in Tinsukia District” in Assam.

NLCPR Committee noted that DPR of the Project has been vetted by M/s WAPCOS Ltd. at estimated cost of Rs. 988.69 Lac.
