



Minutes of the 15th Inter Ministerial Committee (IMC)/NESIDS Committee meeting held on 18.06.2019 at 09.30 am in the Conference Hall-A at Vigyan Bhawan Annexe, New Delhi under the Chairmanship of Secretary, MDoNER.

List of participants is at **Annexure-A**.

2. The meeting of 15th Inter Ministerial Committee (IMC)/ NESIDS Committee was held on 18.06.2019 at 09.30 am to discuss the proposals for sanction of financial assistance for construction of damaged/washed away infrastructure caused by flood in 2017. Chief Secretaries of all concerned states co-chaired the meeting

3. It was noted that Hon'ble PM had announced an assistance of over Rs.2000.00 Crores for relief, rehabilitation, reconstruction and flood mitigation to the North Eastern States in the month of August, 2017, and out of the total package, M/o DoNER has been mandated to release central assistance of Rs.200.00 Crores for the damaged infrastructure in the flood affected 5 states.

4. The following allocation of financial assistance of Rs.200 crore amongst states was made on pro-rata basis with respect to recommendation of Inter-Ministerial Central Team (IMCT) with approval of MoS (I/C):-

5. State Governments placed the list of proposals (enclosed at **Annexure – I**) in accordance with their allocation for financial assistance for construction of totally damaged/washed away infrastructure caused by flood in 2017. The projects were deliberated in the review meetings, held on 19th Mar and 30th Apr 2019. The state governments explained that these projects are for re-building washed away/damaged infrastructure during floods in 2017, and execution of these projects would also aid preventive measures against floods.

6. Detailed presentations were made by the State representatives on these project proposals (Presentation made by the representatives of State Govt. during the meeting are at Annexure II).

7. After detailed deliberation the committee recommended to grant, one time central financial assistance, commensurate to the state allocations, to execute the proposed

projects. The release will be under newly created sub-head "Natural Calamity" for which funds are being re-appropriated. The recommendations are subject to following conditions:

(a) Subject to availability of budget, entire approved cost (limited to the entitlement of the state, as given in para 5 above) would be released in one installment.

(b) Works are to be awarded within three months.

(c) Utilisation Certificates, photographs, completion certificates should be submitted to the Ministry of DoNER in a time bound manner.

(d) The State Government should put in place a robust monitoring and supervision mechanism, including regular inspections by the State Government officers, both from the state headquarters and field. It should be ensured that there are no time and cost overruns and / or any leakages/ pilferage/ misappropriation, and full benefit of such projects reach the intended beneficiaries.

(e) It should be ensured that the funds are utilised for the projects as sanctioned only, and not for other works.

(f) Further the State government need to take requisite steps and make necessary budgetary provisions for upkeep and maintenance of the assets created under such projects so that they survive for their planned life span without deterioration in its quality or suffer untimely damages.

(g) A board should be put up at each site, right from the date work is awarded, giving brief project details at a glance, for the information of general public.

(h) The payment towards various taxes/levies etc. in the recommended projects will be made as per accepted norms of the Ministry.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the chair.
