# Minutes of the 4<sup>th</sup> Empowered Inter-Ministerial Committee (EIMC) Meeting of PM-DevINE scheme held on 06.11.2023 at Vigyan Bhawan Annexe, New Delhi

The fourth meeting of the Empowered Inter-Ministerial Committee (EIMC) for the PM-DevINE scheme was held on November 6, 2023, at Vigyan Bhawan Annexe, New Delhi. The meeting was chaired by the Secretary, Ministry of Development of North Eastern Region (MDoNER) and aimed to deliberate on the project proposals submitted by the North Eastern states and other agencies for implementation. The meeting was attended by Chief Secretaries and senior officials from the North Eastern States, as well as Senior Officers from relevant Central Ministries and Departments. The list of participants is at **Annexure.** 

- 2. At the outset, Chairperson and Secretary, MDoNER welcomed all officers present both physically and virtually and after introductory remark, he asked Sr. Economic Adviser, MDoNER to start presentation wherein the agenda of the meeting was discussed starting with ATR on the minutes of the last EIMC meeting held on 26.9.2023, followed by scrutiny of new candidate projects/ review of ongoing projects State-wise starting with Assam. A summary of agenda-wise discussions and decisions taken by the EIMC is as follows:
  - a. **Confirmation of the minutes of the last EIMC meeting:** Minutes of the 3<sup>rd</sup> EIMC meeting held on 26.9.2023 were issued on 5th October, 2023. As no comments were received on the minutes, therefore the minutes of last meeting were considered as confirmed.
  - b. **ATR on earlier selected project of Meghalaya:** One project of Meghalaya viz. 'construction of new four lane road and conversion of existing two-lane road into four lane with cycling tracks, utility ducts, footpaths, etc. at New Shillong Township at a cost of Rs.146.79 cr.' was selected earlier in 2<sup>nd</sup> meeting of the EIMC held on 14.12.2022. State Govt. of Meghalaya was advised to furnish point-wise reply/ compliance to the comments/observations of MoRTH in their revised DPR and submit the compliance report to MDoNER by 14.11.2023. The project will be taken up in the next EIMC meeting.
  - c. The ongoing projects (wherein AFS already issued), In-principle recommended projects and the new candidate project proposals: The status of the projects was discussed with the respective Chief Secretaries and the representatives of the concerned Central Ministry/Department/Agency. 3. The Chairperson of the EIMC advised the States of Arunachal Pradesh, Manipur, Meghalaya and Nagaland to pose additional and impactful projects in line with the Scheme guidelines & within their balance share of indicated normative outlays under the scheme. The States were also advised that new proposals should refrain from including non-admissible elements such as auditoriums, boundary walls, guest houses, office complexes etc., as per the revised scheme guidelines.

- 4. It was informed that EIMC meetings are scheduled to be convened on the 6th day of every month without exception and accordingly States and other organizations were requested to submit their proposals complete in all respects, by the 20th day of each month. This schedule provides Ministry of DoNER with adequate time to get feedback/ comments from the line ministries/ departments concerned.
- 5. Finally, the Chairperson of the EIMC instructed the FTSUs to get in touch with the Planning Department of the State Governments and the Implementing Agencies to gather scheme-wise and project-wise data from them and furnish the same to the Ministry periodically, in particular for the purpose of projecting project-wise and scheme-wise Expenditure by the Ministry.

The meeting ended with the Vote of Thanks to the Chair and to all.
