**Subject:** Project proposals posed to the EIMC of NESIDS-OTRI in its 39<sup>th</sup> and 40<sup>th</sup> meetings held on 10.3.2023 and 28.3.2023 respectively for selection/sanction of projects under NESIDS-OTRI component – conveying Minutes cum approval of the competent authority regarding.

**Madam/ Sir,**

I am directed to refer to the 39<sup>th</sup> and 40<sup>th</sup> meetings of the Empowered Inter-Ministerial Committee (EIMC) of North East Special Infrastructure Development Scheme (NESIDS)-Other Than Road Infrastructure (OTRI) component held on 10<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup> March 2023 respectively, wherein the project proposals submitted by NE States for selection/ sanction etc. under NESIDS-OTRI and other issues related to ongoing projects sanctioned under NESIDS/NLCPR were deliberated upon.

2. In this regard, it is stated that the competent authority has considered the deliberations of the 39<sup>th</sup> and 40<sup>th</sup> meetings of the EIMC of NESIDS-OTRI, and has decided in respect of the following project proposals as indicated under column of the table below:

3. The competent authority has also approved the proposal of Government of Manipur for condonation of delay in issuing of work order in respect of the already sanctioned NESIDS project "Construction of Building for 52 Anganwadi Centres with Toilet and Rain Water Harvesting in Manipur".

4. The proposal of Government of Meghalaya for change in location of 02 Anganwadi Centres viz. (i) from Pyndenumsaw-4 to Mawlangwir-5; and (ii) from Cherengkeragittim to




Nagrajora in respect of the ongoing sanctioned project "Construction of 23 Anganwadi Centre Buildings in Meghalaya" under NESIDS has also been approved by the competent authority.

This may also be treated as the combined minutes of 39th & 40th EIMCs as approved by the competent authority for the Scheme in the light of fresh Guidelines for NESIDS-OTRI issued by Ministry of DoNER vide No. NESIDS/4/2020-US(NLCPR)-E.Com. No. 114461 dated 21st August 2023 and relevant directions in this regard.
