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The 45<sup>th</sup> meeting of Empowered Inter-Ministerial Committee (EIMC)/ North East Special Infrastructure Development Scheme (NESIDS) and Special Development Packages of Autonomous Councils of Assam Committee was held on 31.01.2024 at 11:00 a.m. to discuss project proposals received from State Governments of Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Manipur, Meghalaya, Nagaland, Tripura, Bodoland Territorial Council (BTC), and Karbi Anglong Autonomous Council (KAATC) for consideration of projects for selection /sanction.
