Minutes of the 15<sup>th</sup> Empowered Inter-Ministerial Committee (EIMC) Meeting of PM-DevINE scheme held on 12.3.2025 at Conference Hall of Jodhpur Officers' Hostel, Pandara Park, India Gate Circle, New Delhi.

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The Fifteenth meeting of the Empowered Inter-Ministerial Committee (EIMC) for the PM-DevINE scheme was held on 12<sup>th</sup> March, 2025 at Conference Hall of Jodhpur Officers' Hostel, Pandara Park, India Gate Circle, New Delhi. The meeting was chaired by the Secretary, Ministry of Development of North Eastern Region (MDoNER). The list of participants is at **Annexure.** 

2. Joint Secretary, In-charge, PM-DevINE Scheme, MDoNER welcomed all Officers present both physically and virtually. After introductory remarks, he, with the permission of the Chair, started presentation wherein the agenda of the meeting was discussed followed by scrutiny of new candidate projects/review of ongoing projects, etc. A summary of agenda-wise discussions and decisions taken by the EIMC, is as follows:

### Agenda I: Confirmation of the minutes of the last EIMC meeting:

Minutes of 14<sup>th</sup> EIMC meeting held on 28<sup>th</sup> January, 2025 were circulated on 24.2.2025. Since no comments were received from the State Governments/ Central Ministries, etc., the Minutes of 14<sup>th</sup> EIMC meeting were considered as confirmed.

### Agenda-II Action Taken Report on the decision of the last meeting:

In the 14<sup>th</sup> EIMC meeting held on 28.01.2025, DPRs of 08 project proposals (worth Rs. 886.77 crore) including 5 for single stage appraisal/approval and Concept Note for 1 proposal were placed before the EIMC. DPR of 1 project proposal (worth Rs.100.95 crore) recommended for approval in the said meeting. DPRs of 06 project proposals including 4 for single stage appraisal/ approval and Concept Note of 1 project proposal were deferred for want of documents/comments of NITI Aayog / concerned line Ministry. On 1 DPR for single stage appraisal/ approval, the Competent Authority made certain observations to be addressed by the Agency concerned.

D/o Sports supported the proposal.


SG submitted that the reply to NITI Aayog's comments, along Annexure-B, had been provided on 28.01.2025, however, the further comments of NITI Aayog.

NITI Aayog stated that they have further examined the proposal and it staff observed that the accommodation component is not admissible as per the scheme guidelines. Also the SG has not furnished the forest clearance.

State Govt. clarified that facilities accommodation provided are only small part of the entire project which will be provided to beneficiaries on a transit basis only permanent not and are accommodation of staff. These transit accommodations do not fall under the negative list of PM-DevINE Scheme quidelines. It was also endorsed by the members of the EIMC as well as PD and AS&FA mentioning that part of accommodation as composite project is very much admissible under the guidelines of the PM-DevINE scheme.

With regard to the environment and forest clearance, SG clarified that the





In the 10<sup>th</sup> meeting of the EIMC held on 10.9.2024, the SG was asked to respond to the observations of the NITI Aayog.

SG response dated 9.9.2024 received on 12.9.2024 on PVS portal was shared with the NITI Aayog on 12.9.2024.

In the 13<sup>th</sup> EIMC meeting held on 27.12.2024, SG was advised to furnish the information sought

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by NITI Aayog.

SG provided the information desired by NITI Aayog on 7.1.2025, which was shared with NITI Aayog on 7.1.2025.

In 14<sup>th</sup> EIMC meeting held on 28.1.2025, NITI Aayog stated that reply of the SG is under examination and comments will be furnished in next 3 days.

Thereafter, nocomments were received from the NITI Aayog; and the proposal was discussed in the 15<sup>th</sup> EIMC meeting on 12.3.2025.




