Item No. 3: Proposal for "Construction of Motorable Suspension Bridge over river Siang at the site of Gandhi Bridge" in Upper Siang District of Arunachal Pradesh

The Committee discussed the proposal and after deducting 1% quality control amounting to Rs.22.13 lac and Sub-soil Investigation amounting to Rs.25.00 lac, recommended the project for sanction at a cost of Rs.2521.77 lac. Details of items of works as under:

Item No.5: Project for 'Construction of RCC Bridge No. 38/1 Inlaipar Channel,, 43/1 & 43/3 on Paikan Channel and 44/2 on Bagha River including approaches and sub-way on Silchar Hailakandi Road in Hailakandi District, Assam'

The Committee noted that D/o R T & H had examined and vetted the DPR. Accordingly, the Committee recommended the proposal for sanction at Rs. 353.13 lac subject to the condition raised by the D/o RT & H that the structure should withstand all combinations of seismic forces in which the Chief Engineer (PWD) has to satisfy himself about the adequacy and safety of all structural components before starting execution. <u>Item No. 6</u>: Project for 'Construction of RCC Bridge No. 4/1 and 15/1 including approaches on Nagaon Bhuragaon Road in Nagaon District (Assam).

As the DORTH had vetted the proposal the NLCPR Committee recommended the project for sanction at a total cost of Rs. 434.40 lac, subject to the condition that the Chief Engineer (PWD) has to satisfy himself about the adequacy and safety of all structural components before starting execution so that the structure withstands all combinations of seismic forces. <u>Item No.7</u>: Proposal for 'Construction of RCC Bridge No. 3/1 on Pukia Silapathar Road in Dhemaji District, Assam' for consideration of sanction.

The Committee noted that this proposal had been considered and retained by the Committee in its 21st meeting held on 4.3.2003. Moreover, D/o RT & H had found the estimated cost of the project which is based on the SOR of 2004-05 to be reasonable. Thus even though the cost of the project is less than Rs. 2.00 crore, but as the project is retained one, therefore, the Committee recommended the proposal for sanction at total cost of Rs.136.78 lac with following items of work:

Item No.8: Proposal for 'Construction of RCC Bridge No. 2/2 and 4/2 including approaches on Gurnagar - Tikrikilla Road in Goalpara District (Assam)' (Estimated cost: Rs. 355.19 lac) for consideration of sanction.

The Committee was informed that D/o RT & H had examined and accepted the DPR at a project cost of Rs. 355.19 lac, subject to the condition that the Chief Engineer (PWD) has to satisfy himself about the adequacy and safety of all structural components before starting execution so that the structure withstands all combinations of seismic forces. Accordingly, the Committee recommended its sanction at total cost of Rs.355.19 lac with following items of work:

Item No.9: Proposal for 'Construction of RCC Bridge No. 1/1 and 4/1 on Nilbagan Hojai Road in Nagaon District, Assam' for consideration of sanction.

The Committee was informed that D/o RT & H has observed that the estimated cost of the project is based on the SOR of 2004-05 and found to be reasonable. The Committee recommended the proposal for sanction at a cost of Rs. 191.67 lac with the following components. Although the cost of the proposal is less than Rs. 2.00 crore but since this proposal is the part of a big retained project for conversion of 75 existing SPT bridges by RCC bridges so it has been recommended.

Item No.10: Proposal for 'Construction of RCC Bridge No. 27/2, 28/1, 29/1, 30/2, 32/2, 35/1 and 45/1 including approaches on Dhubri Kachugaon Road in Kokrajhar District, Assam' for consideration of sanction.

The Committee was informed that D/o RT & H had examined and accepted the DPR at the cost of the project at Rs. 516.40 lac, subject to the condition that the Chief Engineer (PWD) has to satisfy himself about the adequacy and safety of all structural components before starting execution so that the structure should withstand all combinations of seismic forces. Accordingly the Committee recommended its sanction at total cost of Rs.516.40 lac with following items of work:

The contingency charges amounting to Rs. 5.10 lac may be reimbursed against actual contingent expenditure on production of documentary evidence but would exclude expenditure on work charged establishment.

<u>Item No.11</u>: Proposal for "Redevelopment of lawmusiang Market for Jaintia Hills Autonomous District Council" at Jowai, Meghalaya

The Committee noted that M/o UD vetted the project at Rs. 18.90 crore and stated that the estimate has been prepared on PAR 2002 & corrected to the present Cost Index provided by competent authority which has been scrutinized

& corrected as per the norms and admissibility as per Plinth Area Rates. The Committee after deliberations recommended the proposal for sanction at a total cost of Rs.1881.74 lac as per the details given below. However, the Committee observed that as the building is proposed to be 8 storeyed, therefore, clearance of Ministry of Urban Development should be obtained whether it is admissible to have 8 storeyed building in that earthquake prone region and whether all provisions for design for earthquake resistance have been provided for in the design of the building.

The 3% contingency charges amounting to Rs. 54.81 lac may be reimbursed against actual contingent expenditure on production of documentary evidence but would exclude expenditure on work charged establishment.

<u>Item No.12:</u> Synchronisation of Rimbi Stage – I, Rimbi – II and Kkhep (Dentam) with the 66 KV State Grid including Renovation and Modernization of Rimbi Stage – I, Rimbi – II and Kkhep

The Committee noted that CEA (MOP) commented that the DPR containing the electrical works has been found to be generally in order and recommended that DoNER may consider funding the electrical works at an estimated cost of Rs. 541.56 lac. Further on civil part CEA recommended that DoNER may consider funding the civil works of the DPR at an estimated cost of Rs. 640.88 lac.

The Committee also noted that IFD have no objection in placing the project before NLCPR Committee at an estimated cost of Rs. 962.32 lac. After discussion, the Committee recommended that the project may be sanctioned as per the following items / components of work.

<u>Item No.13:</u> Project, 'Improvement of Banikya Chowmuhani – Salbagan road (9.121 Km.)' in Tripura, for sanction.

The Committee was informed that D/o RT & H have mentioned that the cost per km. works out to Rs. 60.42 lac per km based on TSR - PWD - 2002 found to be in order including the Cost Index @22.5%. As per the policy the Committee after deducting 1% Quality Control amounting Rs.4.66 lac, Road Side Accommodation @ 1% (Rs.4.70 lac), Work Charged Establishment @1.5% (Rs.7.12 lac) and Agency Charges as the State PWD would implement the project @11% (Rs.54.61 lac), recommended the proposal for sanction at total cost of Rs.476.92 lac. The following observations of the D/o RT & H are also to be communicated to the State Government

- i. It is reiterated that all out effort may be made to provide maximum possible radius of curve to offer minimum turning circle of a vehicle as stipulated in Clause No. 4.4.5 of IRC: 38-1998 and where reduction of design speed is absolute necessary, the same should not be changed abruptly, in such situation proper warning sign should also be erected well ahead of the point of danger.
- ii. The aggregate length of the drain has been modified from 1824.20 m to 6840.75 m without giving justification for the same. State Chief Engineer may re-examine the proposal and approve at his end as per actual requirements adapting to the possible extent the least minimum prescribed slope.

The contingency charges amounting to Rs.11.40 lac may be reimbursed against actual contingent expenditure on production of documentary evidence but would exclude expenditure on work charged establishment.

<u>Item No.14:</u> Proposal for replacement of 2 existing semi permanent timber (SPT) bridges in Tripura on Kamalpur-Maracherra-Ambassa Road by RCC bridges, for sanction -

- i. Bridge over river Taijanticherra at Ch. 23.85 Km. &
- ii. Bridge over river Salemacherra at Ch. 24.45 Km.

The Committee was informed that revised DPRs of the two bridges have been examined and accepted by the D/o RT & H with following conditions:

- i. State Chief Engineer may satisfy himself about adequacy of bearing capacity of soil at founding level. In case, actual bearing pressure exceeded the proposed SBC of soil, design has to be reviewed at the end of the State Chief Engineer
- ii. The State Chief Engineer may satisfy himself about structural safety and stability of proposed various components of the sub-structure, super structure for the bridges based on the detailed design prepared for approved GAD taking cognizance of the latest revision of various bridge codes and latest Ministry's guidelines. The working drawings good for the construction for each and every component of the bridges shall be approved by the State PWD Chief Engineer, at his end and form part of the tender document.
- iii. State Chief Engineer before actual execution of the work may approve the proposal at his end. Copy of the approved DPR may be forwarded to this Ministry for reference and record.

Although the D/o RT & H has considered the cost 'reasonable' but the Committee as per the policy deliberated to recommend sanctioning of the project after deducting the inadmissible items like Quality Control (1%), Anticipated Tender Premium (15%), Price Escalation (7.5%), WC Establishment (1½%), and Agency Charges (11%) as the State PWD would implement the project at total cost of Rs.427.77 lac. The items of work approved by the Committee are as under:

Item No.15: Proposal, 'Construction of Zohmun - Tinghmun Road (10.36 km), in Mizoram' for deletion from the list of retained projects from the Priority List 2003-04.

In view of the fact that the proposed road was already constructed by Rural Development Department of the State and is again already selected for construction under PMGSY, the Committee recommended for deletion of the proposal from the list of retained projects from the Priority List 2003-04 of Mizoram.
